Horrors & History

Your first stop on this spooky adventure is **The Proprietary House** in Perth Amboy. Built in 1762, stories of the occupants who never left live on today. Trustees claim to have witnessed a woman in white appearing in the window and heard footsteps running up and down the back staircase. But the biggest fright comes from the tearoom, where guests swear they feel someone grabbing the back of their necks.

Your next location brings you into Metuchen to the **Ayers-Allen House** where multiple ghosts have been spotted from soldiers to mercenaries to unjustly treated Native Americans. You may even hear the cries of a mother still searching for her son who was killed by British soldiers.

AFTERNOON ADVENTURES

Continue your adventure in Cranbury – a 30-minute ride from Metuchen.

Be(ware) Our Guests

Get lunch at one of the most haunted places in the County – **Cranbury Inn**. Officially established in 1780, the inn housed guests until 1982 and still serves as a delicious restaurant today.

Some staff members insist they've received telepathic messages from guests "long gone" – warning them to turn off electrical fixtures. Another rumor speaks of an old man hit by a stagecoach in the 1790s who never left, but not to worry, while he may not enjoy renovations, he seems not to mind guests. In fact, when psychics and paranormal investigators have visited the inn, they say the spirits are warm and welcoming – clearly enjoying (after) life at the inn.
